The 29th World Investment Conference and the 8th Sharjah Investment Forum (the twin events) will take place from 21 to 23 October in Sharjah, UAE. It is also the year that marks 30th anniversary of WAIPA. The twin events will be jointly organized by World Association of Investment Promotion Agencies, the Sharjah FDI Office and the UAE Ministry of Investment.

#### **Overview of the Twin Events**

The WAIPA World Investment Conference (WIC) is a premier global forum for investment stakeholders to engage on emerging challenges and opportunities that shape international investment flows and promotion strategies. Since its inception in 1996, WIC has played a key role in advancing investment promotion and facilitation, fostering strategic partnerships, and driving policy advocacy. The **Sharjah Investment Forum (SIF)** is a leading investment conference and exhibition in the MENA region. It is the annual flagship of Sharjah FDI Office, the FDI promotion arm of the Sharjah Government. Both serve as flatforms for actionable dialogue, best-practice sharing, and launching key tools and initiatives that contribute to sustainable investment and development.

#### **Global Context: Key and Emerging Challenges and opportunities**

The twin events will take place against a backdrop of complex global transformations: geopolitical dynamics, sustainability imperatives, technological advancement, and shifting global value chains are redefining the investment landscape. These dynamics demand adaptive strategies, stronger global cooperation, and novel investment models that are inclusive, resilient, and sustainable.

## Theme, Objectives, and Expected Outcomes

Under the theme "Transforming Our World: Investing for a Resilient and Sustainable Future," the twin events will promote public-private collaboration, responsible investment, and innovative financing to address global challenges. The event aims to realign national investment strategies with evolving global realities, support the launch of a "Decade of Promoting Investment for Good," and catalyze long-term initiatives for inclusive, sustainable development. It will generate high-level policy dialogue, strengthen institutional capacity, and enhance cross-border cooperation.

#### Structure, Participation, and Partnerships

The twin events will bring together global investment leaders, ministers, CEOs, IPAs, investors, and international institutions. Key highlights include a Grand Opening, Global Leaders' Insights, Ministerial Roundtable, Investment Excellence Awards, High-level Multi-stakeholders Panels, Deal Making Platform, and Executives' Strategic Focus. The program also features Thematic Tracks on AI and digital investment, new sources of financing, FDI in services, agribusiness, and more. A number of signature sessions will be co-hosted with international organizations, including ICC, IEDC, ILO, ITC, OECD, UNCTAD, UNIDO, UNWTO, World Bank. Open to all participants, the twin events will emphasize inclusivity, innovation, and forward-looking, reinforcing the two global forums' leadership and commitment to shaping a sustainable investment future.
